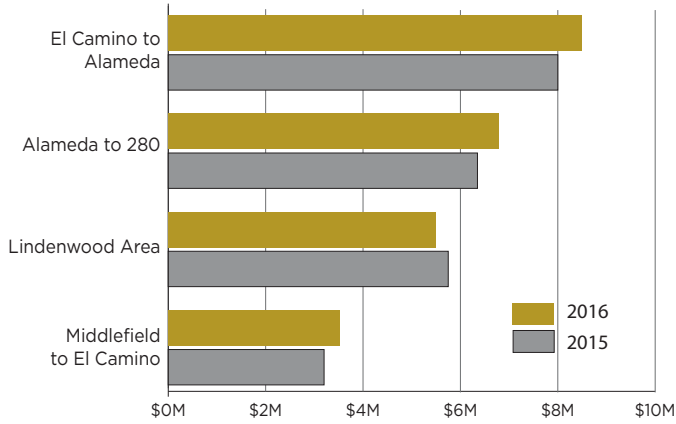

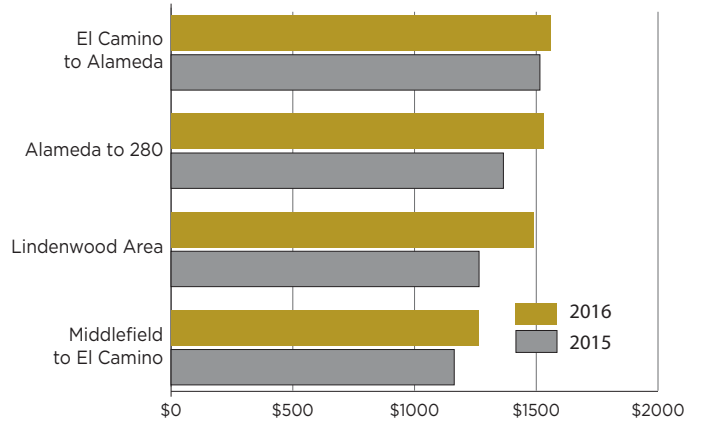

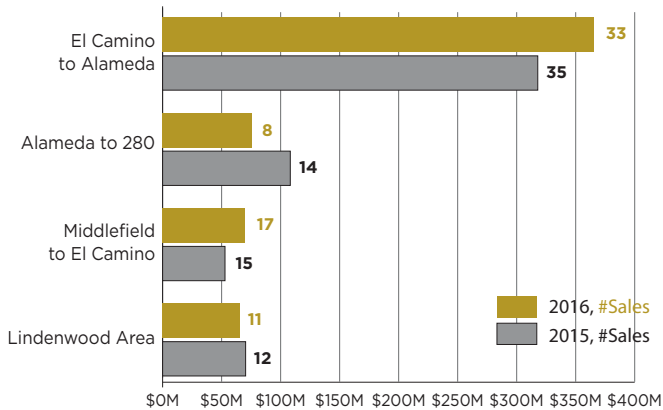


PRICE PER SQUARE FOOT
